



UI Public Wireless Instructions

Getting Started:

1. Open your wireless Internet Connection settings. Select "UIpublicWiFi" as your network.
2. Open your preferred web browser (i.e., Internet Explorer, Safari, Firefox). Read and accept all security certificates.
3. After you accept all security certificates, your browser should open to the UI Public Wireless main page.
4. From the main page, you must **accept the Terms of Use** for the service and **enter all the required user information**. (User information will not be shared for marketing purposes; for more information, please see our Privacy Policy on the UI Public Wireless login page.)

You are now ready to surf the web! With UI Public Wireless, you can browse the web, send and receive web-based email, and chat with an instant messaging client.

Who should use UI Public Wireless:

- You're a visitor with no affiliation with the University of Illinois.
- You don't have a uiuc.edu, uic.edu, or uis.edu email account.

Who should NOT use UI Public Wireless:

- You have an email address ending in uiuc.edu, uic.edu, uis.edu.
- You have a guest account with the University.

If you meet any of these conditions, you should use **UIUCnet Wireless (SSID: UIUCnet)**, connecting either by a Virtual Private Networking (VPN) client or through the QuickConnect login page.

Why use UIUCnet Wireless instead of UI Public Wireless?

- UIUCnet Wireless is **faster** than UI Public Wireless.
- UIUCnet Wireless **doesn't** require registration; UI Public Wireless **does**.
- UIUCnet Wireless allows you **full access** to University resources; UI Public Wireless **limits** your access.
